## Jetty Villas Community Landscape

## **Mission Statement**

To beautify and maintain our Jetty Villas landscape through community input and support, creating a more sustainable landscape that relies on Florida-friendly and native plantings, increases canopy, reduces maintenance, and, over time, becomes a Florida-friendly landscape.

## Goals:

- Create a planning, advisory group, with a Board member as liaison, to oversee landscape planning, identify and prioritize areas of need, and purchase of new trees and plants in coordination with community input and advice of Florida-friendly tree and plant experts.
- Create small working groups to give input for planning and assist with maintenance of a specific area. [Create a landscape work-order system to address specific member needs.]
- Select for planting only Florida-friendly and native perennials and trees that are both salt- and drought-tolerant to reduce the need for irrigation and pest control and that are the right size in the right place to reduce pruning. [Adopt an approved list for new purchases.]
- Increase landscape canopy by planting more trees and single-stem bushes that can be grown as trees to help filter harsh sunlight and allow lower plants to thrive.
- Implement once- or twice-a-year rejuvenation pruning and reduce machine trimming to extend the beauty and life of plantings.
- Determine when and where mulch is needed, including use of stone where drainage is a concern.
- Establish on-going communication with the entire community about landscape planning, activities, and progress, including newsletter updates and Board meeting reports.
